- 1. Develop a Citizens' Agricultural Policy (CAP). Democratise food governance.
- 2. Values are key: society wants cheap food not sustainable!
- 3. Need to develop a completely new food distribution system and a UK "Sustainable Food Act" to shape the future
- 4. Stop focusing on "organic" and "talking to ourselves"; help citizens to make informed choices based on the benefits of organic food. Organic ≠ good (corporate agri...)
- 5. Instead of public money for public goods, community engagement and protectionism plus bottom-up innovation?
- 6. "What is land for?" is the fundamental question that needs to be addressed through consultation with representatives across the entire supply chain.
