## Woodfuel from Agroforestry

The theme of this year's Farm Woodland Forum meeting is woodfuel from agroforestry. Based on the Organic Research Centre's Elm Farm, near Newbury, the meeting will include a tour of the various agroforestry demonstrations including managing hedgerows for bioenergy production, a short rotation coppice silvopastoral system and some new hedgerow and parkland plantings.

Postgraduate students can apply for the Lynton Incoll Memorial Scholarship to cover expenses incurred (travel, registration, food and accommodation: maximum of £200). To apply for this scholarship, applicants must submit an abstract (of no more than 300 words) for a poster or oral presentation that they will present at the Annual Meeting, with a brief biography and a supporting letter from the course director confirming their registration on a relevant course at a UK university and their identity. The abstract can relate to proposals / projects at an early stage of development, as well as completed studies.
