Lynton Incoll Memorial Scholarship



Lynton Incoll (1937-2012) was a graduate of the University of Melbourne who worked for many years at the University of Leeds. He was a well respected plant physiologist who was Chairman of the UK Agroforestry Forum (the first name for the Farm Woodland Forum) from 2002 to 2006.

In memory of the valuable contributions that Lynton made to Agroforestry, a scholarship has been established in his memory. Administered by the Farm Woodland Forum (FWF), the scholarship is to enable a postgraduate student to attend the Farm Woodland Forum Annual Meeting. Up to £200 is available for expenses incurred (travel, registration, food and accommodation).

To apply for this scholarship, applicants must submit an abstract (of no more than 300 words) for a poster or oral presentation that they will present at the Annual Meeting, with a brief biography and a supporting letter from the course director confirming their registration on a relevant course at a UK university and their identity. The abstract can relate to proposals / projects at an early stage of development, as well as completed studies.

The 2015 FWF Annual Meeting will take place 18-19 May 2015 at the Organic Research Centre, Berkshire, RG20 0HR, England.

The deadline for applications is 17th April 2015
