### Developing Alternative Legume Mixes – The Farmer's Perspective John Newman

 Trial plot sown alongside our usual white clover mix:

3kg Premium PRG 6kg Orion PRG – organic 4.9 kg Foxtrot PRG – organic 4.9kg Dolina Timothy – organic 1.8kg Alice White Clover 1.82kg Tribute White Clover 1.24kg Birdsfoot Trefoil San 1.24kg Chicory 25.8kg/ha – 65% organic

### Establishment

- Ploughed 10.03.09
- 3 cultivations in April and 2 in June 09 weed strikes
- Drilled 12.06.09 Horsch drill (drill carried above ground – ASM difficult to calibrate)
- Flat rolled

Both the usual ley mix and the ASM were planted at the same time. Previous cropping 4 years arable – high levels of weeds particularly docks Initially ASM did not look as good as our usual mix


## The Researcher/Scientist's Perspective

#### Legume LINK: Report for Abbey Home Farm – March 2011 Crop species in All Species Mix (ASM) and control ley in 2009 and 2010

The table below shows the average ground cover (measured in four 0.25m<sup>2</sup> quadrats) of the ASM and control ley and each of their component species. The ASM has fared well in comparison to the control which is already quite species rich, and most of the species are still present one year after sowing. As the graph on page 2 displays, the species richness of the ASM is above average on Abbey Home Farm.

I have also included some soil results that we collected in Spring 2009 at the start of the trial. We will collect soil samples from the plots again this year, and I will forward the results to you when the samples have been analyzed.

### The Farmer's Perspective

- The trial strip has retained it's diversity
- Assessment of the strip v the rest of the field by eye shows greater height and volume of forage (cocksfoot/lucerne and red clover grew particularly well)
- Recorded yields of forage have been higher by 50%
- Both ewes and lambs have preferentially grazed the strip

 Weed levels now appear lower than the usual ley mix

### Farm Outcomes

- Increased use of lucerne on farm
  9.4 kg Marshall lucerne/9kg Milvus/8.6kg Polim
- Introduced cocksfoot into our ley mixture 3kg Premium PRG/5kg Orion PRG/5kg TwystarPRG/5kg Cocksfoot Prairial/2kg Ragnor Timothy/2kg Alice WC/2kg Aran WC/0.75kg Birds Foot Trefoil/0.75kg Chicory/05kg Trefoil Virgo Pajberg
