The turkey flock arrives at the farm in July and from four weeks old they are allowed field range and access to woodland.

The objective of B-BOP is to promote genuine information exchange in order to develop and promote best practice in organic poultry production. It hopes to encourage new entrants into organic poultry production and to protect and enhance organic poultry standards.
