Assessments included biomass scoring, ground cover, disease and pest occurrence, root nodulation and the number of flowers or pods per stem





As ignificant a gronomic challenge in bean cultivation is managing soil-borne diseases, particularly Fusarium foot rot.

It impairs water uptake by reducing root size and causing root blackening, which can lead to significant yield losses.




Futura has had the highest biomass score and the greatest yield
